Student Success Plan Update / Principal's Report	 Primary-3, reading results. Missing data from 2 classes as data is only due by the end of this week. Based on current data, 100/115 students are meeting expectations. Focus on these 15 children to determine what interventions could look like such as additional resources.

Additional Agenda Items Added:	 New online meals: live October 18th, first delivery was Monday Oct 28th. – Meals are going well now. Different vendors around HRM. Grade 4/5s volunteer and delivery food/supplies, as vendors haven't found staff to do delivery within the school to classrooms. Vendors accepting feedback and adjusted. Estimates ½ of each class each day orders. Culture fair feedback got more responses for a daytime event. Planned to happen in January 2024. Cookbooks. Need to find time to make it happen – we do have information from another school. Kim can send the information regarding the process out, and perhaps a subcommittee could help. Subcommittee could do editing. Another suggestion to have sponsors in the book to help cover cost. In future years, consider concerts at Brookside Junior High, more space. Coordinate day after/before their concerts to keep chairs setup. Could fundraise with SEC for other purposes such as class trips.
