Safe Arrival

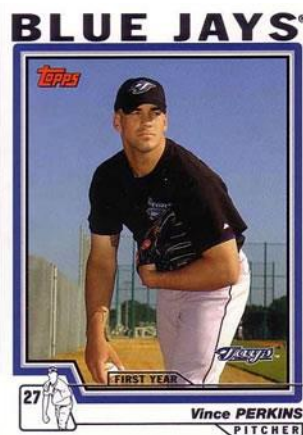

Indigenous Athlete of the Month

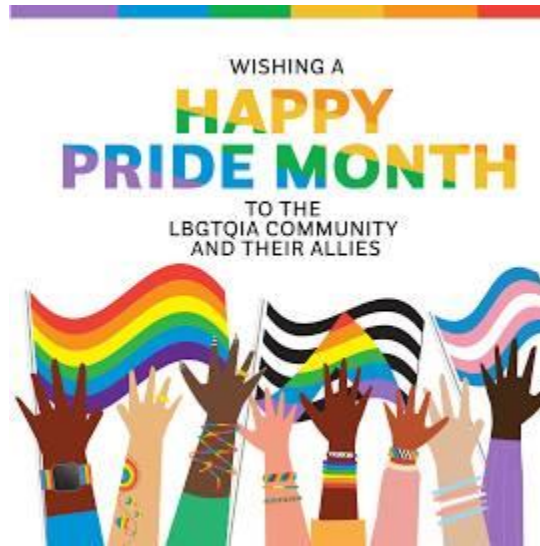
National Indigenous History Month in Canada is observed in June, a time to recognize and celebrate the history, heritage, resilience, and diversity of First Nations, Inuit, and Métis peoples. National Indigenous Peoples Day, celebrated on June 21st, is a specific day within this month dedicated to further recognizing these communities.



Mark Vincent Perkins was born in 1981 and is from Victoria, British Columbia. He is of Métis First Nation heritage. Perkins is a professional baseball player who played as a pitcher. In 2009, he competed in the Caribbean World Series. That same year, he also pitched in Rome during the World Cup of Baseball. Over the course of his career, he played for several teams, including the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Toronto Blue Jays, Chicago Cubs, and Iowa Cubs. Additionally, he pitched for the Leones de Ponce in the Dominican Republic.
