Business arising from the meeting minutes	1) <u>Outstanding funding requests</u> Due to the number of attendees, it was decided that the decision would be deferred to an online vote. The results will be ratified at the next SAC meeting.

Student Success Plan Update / Principal's Report	1) <u>Math Data</u> Recent results showed a 'plateau' in progress; actions are being taken such as a math coach visiting the school/with teachers 2) <u>Literacy Data</u>
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	Reading results continue to improve and are a strong metric for the school; writing development isn't progressing as quickly and teachers are receiving ongoing professional development to help develop alternate ways of addressing this. Teaching support teams are also in place to look at individual data and what can be done to address any issues identified. Tier 1 and Tier 2 supports are in place. <u>3) Other (Wellness Initiatives, etc.)</u> Staff are implementing a support system that includes an 'adopt-a-student' model. This intentionally connects with students who may need additional support with teachers (often not their classroom teacher).
New Business	1) <u>Code of Conduct Review</u> A new code will be put in place this fall by EECD and includes new definitions of unacceptable behaviour (not just 'disruptive'); safety risks are considered by age and stage of development; mental health and bullying are now also included. 2) <u>School Photographer</u> It was confirmed that all photographers/photography companies working in schools will need to send written confirmation that none of their data is housed outside of Canada AND that photographs are deleted after use that school year. Information from multiple photographers was reviewed, however there was general agreement that Adams Photography was the top contender for 2027/26, based on the diversity of their team and their rapport with students.
